INSTRUCTIONS:

- Entries should be submitted to the Youth Services Desk. Separate cover sheets are needed for each entry.
- You may enter as many categories as you like, however, you may only enter two pieces per category and only win one prize overall.
- MUSIC/PERFORMANCE/FILM recordings should be submitted in a downloadable format to shelby.r@hutchpl.org. Cover sheets for music entries can be filled out and submitted electronically as a photo or a scan in the same email as your entry, or submitted inperson to the Youth Services Desk.
- Prizes (in Hutchbucks) of \$30 for first place, \$20 for second place, and \$10 for third place, will be awarded in each format and each age group.
- **DEADLINE** for entry is November 29th, 2025.
- Winners will be announced mid-December. Contestants will be contacted directly via email or phone call with the contest results.
- All entries will be showcased at the library's Teen Coffeehouse in January. Entries can be picked up following the coffeehouse or anytime after that from the Youth Services Desk.
